

REGULAR MEETING (2)
MAY 26TH, 2021 5:00 P.M.
KENTLAND TOWN HALL

Attending: Debby Shufflebarger and James Sammons, Council Members and Judy King, Clerk/Treasurer

A motion was made by James Sammons and seconded by Debby Shufflebarger to open the bids for the second round of paving for the Town. Debby will have TJ Firkins get with Ken Smith to advertise for the bidding.

The Kentland Depot was rented over the weekend and two chairs were broken during the rental. Debby Shufflebarger spoke with Town Attorney, Pat Ryan, and Pat told Debby that we have the option to bill the party that broke the chairs. Judy King looked into pricing and ordering new chairs and was told they come in sets of 4 with the table. A motion was made by Debby Shufflebarger and seconded by James Sammons to invoice the party for the entire set minus their deposit.

A change order for the New Fire House had additional fees. NIPSCO of \$7,343.17 to bring power to the Fire House and also, an expense of \$2,875.00 for boring under the road to bring the power to the Fire House. The labor costs for this, will be paid by Equiteam.

The Town received a new quote for health insurance through IPEP which provided better coverage for the employees and families, less out of pocket expenses, lower deductibles and a lower cost to the Town. This coverage would go into effect July 1st, 2021 with no lapse of coverage to the individuals. A motion was made by Debby Shufflebarger and seconded by James Sammons to approve PPO10RXE5 coverage for the Town of Kentland at a cost of \$7,054.00 per month.

Debby received information from Holly Porter in regards to the swim bus to bring participants to the pool from Brook and Goodland. They will not be able to provide service at this time due to people leaving.

TJ Firkins is to obtain quotes for the property at 106 North Third Street for paving the parking lot. \$35,000.00 was given to the Town of Kentland from Newton County Economic Development to resurface the lot.

Being no further business, a motion was made by Debby Shufflebarger and seconded by James Sammons to adjourn the meeting.
