

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-03-09-1  
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND § 53.26 OF THE KENTLAND TOWN CODE

The Town Council of the Town of Kentland, having determined that certain parts of Kentland Code § 53.26 require updating, now makes the following recitals and amends the ordinance in the following manner:

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Kentland has an ordinance connection charges for the town's sewer system; and,

**WHEREAS**, the provisions set forth therein establish a cost to be paid by a sewer customer to compensate the Town of Kentland for labor, material and overhead necessary for connecting a customer to the sanitary sewer system of the town; and,

**WHEREAS**, the costs incurred by the Town of Kentland have significantly increased since the passage of the current ordinance; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council desires to increase the amount of said connection charges to more accurately reflect the current costs to the Town of Kentland.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KENTLAND, INDIANA** as follows:

§ 53.26(B) shall be amended to read as follows:


"In the event of connection of property to the town's existing sanitary sewer, there shall be a connection charge of \$1,000 for residential customers and \$2,000 for commercial customers, for the privilege of connection to the sanitary sewer system of the town"


This Ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect after its passage and approval by the Town Council, and upon its publication as required by law.
